

Simple Addition


Simply write the answer in each circle.




Two red double-decker buses stacked vertically plus one red double-decker bus equals a circle containing a question mark.

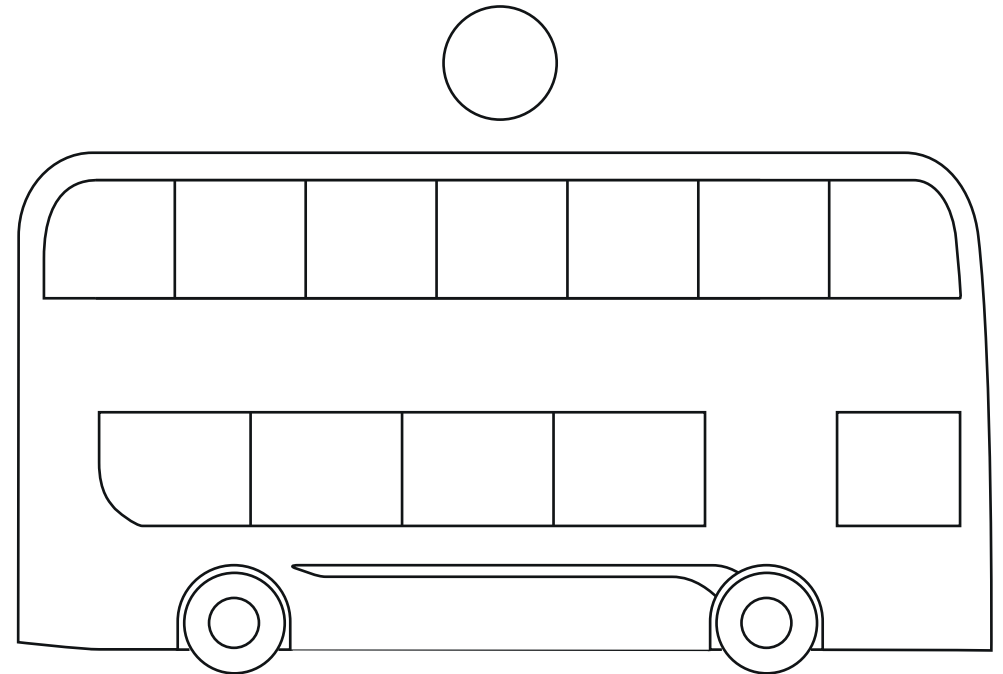
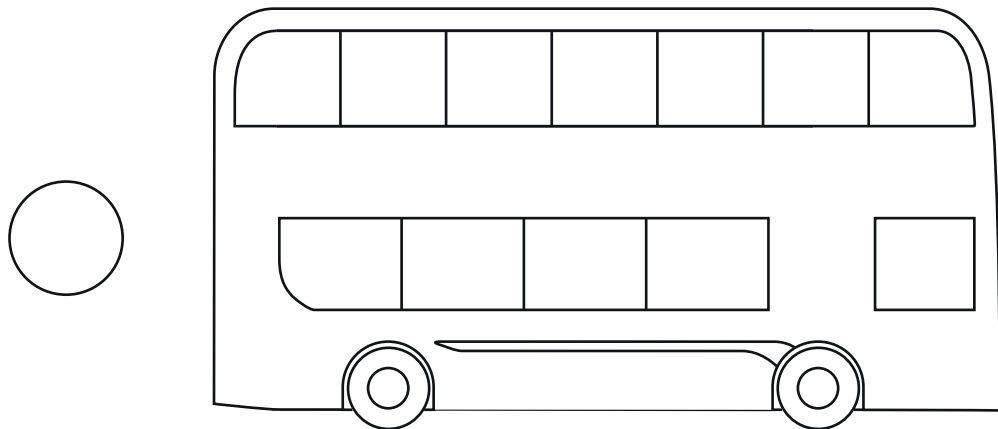
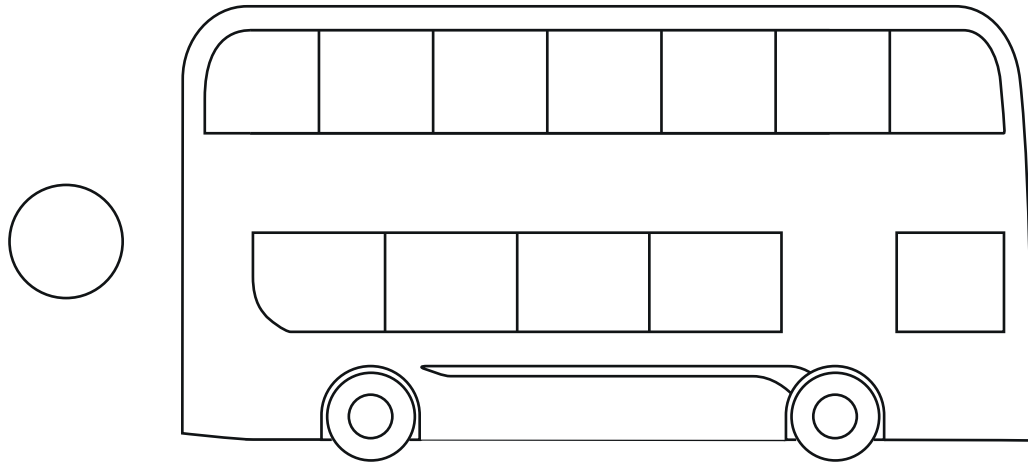
Five blue double-decker buses: one on top, two in the middle, and two on the bottom plus two blue double-decker buses stacked vertically equals a circle containing a question mark.
